### UPDATE from LGRSC Vice President/Archery Director, Duane Turner

We are now six weeks into the 11-week indoor 3D archery season. We are still averaging more than 30 shooters per week. The final five weeks will prove to be interesting as all three classes can still be won by anybody. If you are interested, you can register on any Monday evening between 6:00 and 7:00 pm until March 18th. Due to the number of shooters, we have also decided to add a traditional league starting February 21st. Start time will be 6:30 pm and should last about 90 minutes. This league will consist of five weeks and will finish up on March 20th.

The club will be hosting a Saginaw Valley Archery tournament on March 2nd, and 3rd. This is a 60 arrow round shot at the NFAA 5 spot target. Fees are \$10 for adults, and \$5 for youth 17 and under. Outdoor 3D league will start April 14th, on Tuesday evenings. 20 3D targets will be set up with a cost of \$10 per week and will cover 11 weeks. The field and hunter league will begin April 9th on Thursday evenings. This league is free for members, or \$5 for non-members per week. Also, do not forget the 4th of July shoot this year. This event will have 30 targets using the full 3D trail. \$12 for adults, and just \$6 for youth 15 and under. The rifle range and pistol pit will be closed Wednesday July 3rd at 5:00 pm for set-up and will re-open at 6:00 pm on July 4th.
