ARCHERY UPDATE

The 2024 indoor archery league will begin on Monday, January 8, 2024. This year we will be shooting 30 3D targets for 11 weeks. Cost will be \$100 if paid in full upfront, or \$12.00 per week. Youth 15 and under will shoot at half price. This league will be a handicap league, and we plan to crown a male, and female open champion, and a recurve champion. The first 10 weeks will be for score, and the 11th week will be championship night. All targets will be a max of 25 yards. If you have never shot indoor 3D before, make sure to come out and at least try it once. Indoor 3D is faster paced than outdoor 3D, as you shoot three arrows each from 10 different stations. You may also begin shooting at any time between 6:00 pm and 7:30 pm. The only stipulation will be that any shooters who arrive at, or a little after 7:30 will have to help us take care of the targets when we are done! I do apologize, but we will not have a paper target, or spot league this winter. I will have a flyer created and posted with the details in the next couple of weeks.

We also just received a new shipment of targets and inserts from Rinehart Targets. This will allow us to replace the worn-out targets and inserts. The new targets provide for a few spare targets in case we lose a couple to damage. Look for these new targets to debut on January 8th!
