#### **ELECTRONIC LOCKS - UPDATE**

We are making progress with the new electronic locks. Electronic locks have been installed on both the club house, and at the main gate. At the main gate, please lock the combination lock to the electronic lock. This way, only one lock will be needed to open the gate. Combination lock on one side of the gate, electronic lock to the other side of the gate. Then lock the two locks to each other.

This will continue to be a work in progress, and we will release the information you need when we are confident that all is working as planned. Duane will put a tutorial together on how this all works when we are ready to release this to the membership.

All you need is a standard smart phone, iPhone, or Android. The combination lock will remain in place for those who do not have a smart phone.
